Roscoe M. Moore		15	Inventor and businessman who was associated with Thomas Edison between 1910 and 1918. He developed a number of inventions, including the klaxon auto horn and a hearing aid. (Montrose)

John H. Yancy		19	Inventor, pioneering agriculturalist, scientist (Tuskegee)
