

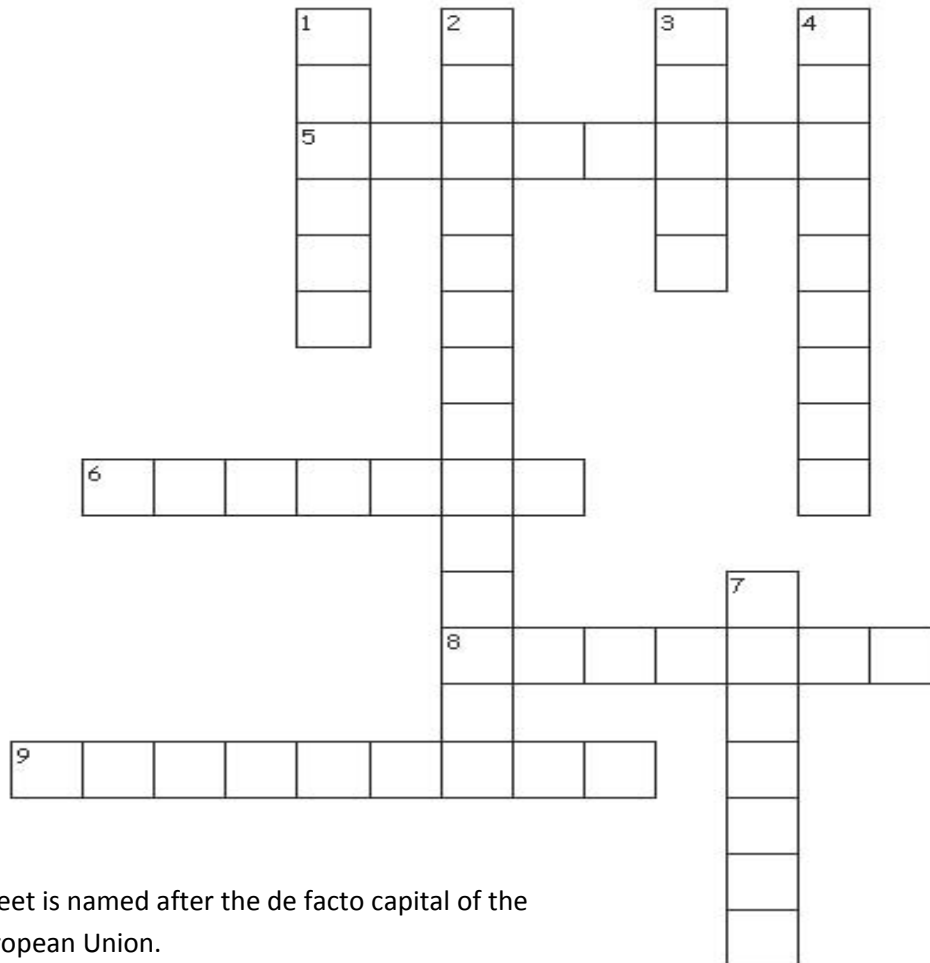

MOBILE INTERNATIONAL STREET NAMES

All the clues are for streets found in Mobile, Alabama, which are named after cities and figures in Europe.



ACROSS

5. This street is named after the de facto capital of the European Union.
6. This street name in Mobile goes back to Guy IV Count of Vienne, France, who had this animal on his coat of arms and was nicknamed after it.
8. The port of this city is one of the biggest ports in the world, ranking third in Europe and within the top 20 globally.
9. Starting as a dam constructed in 1270 on the Rotte River what city is this?

DOWN

1. Founded as a Viking settlement, this is now the capital city of a European island nation.
2. This parkway has the same name as the tenth episode of the second season of the syndicated science fiction television series Star Trek: The Next Generation, the 36th episode overall.
3. This street is named after the capital and largest city of the East Flanders province.
4. This is the capital city of a nation whose seat of government is located in The Hague.
7. This name comes from Béal Feirste, meaning "mouth of the sandbanks" and is a city on an island nation of Europe.
